Our deepest sympathy to Shirley Daly on the passing away of her brother, Edmond Brennan on August 18th.

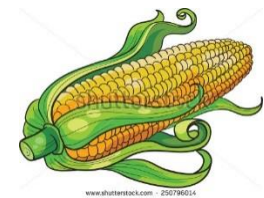
