We are grateful for this generous contribution that will help us with our expenses and we also thank Mr. Mathieu Levesque for his generosity.

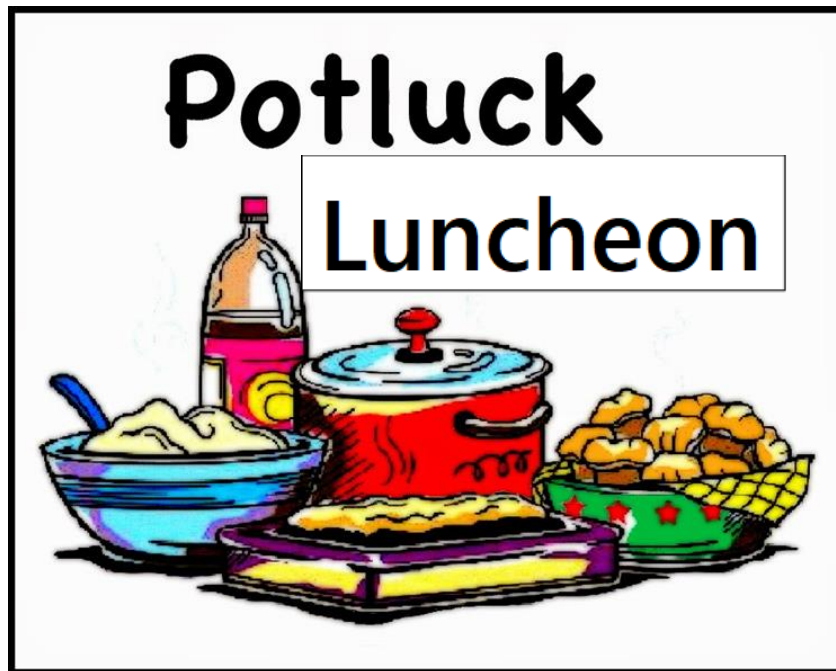
