ST. AL'S SEWING GROUP



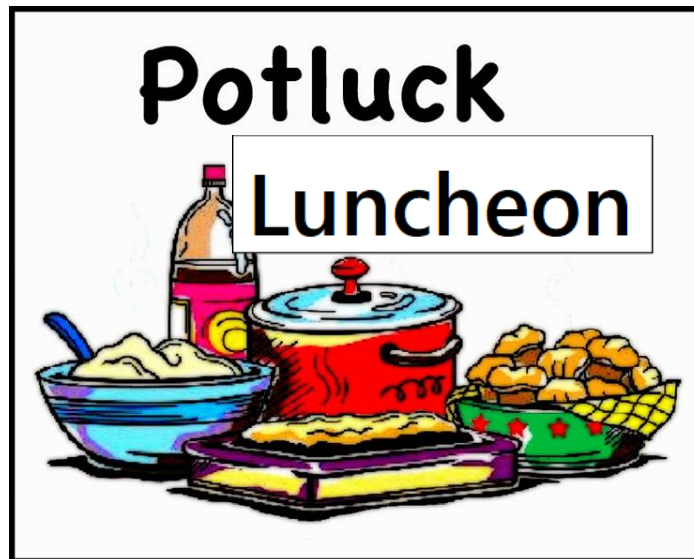
