First Reconciliation & First Communion will begin in early January on Sundays after mass (12:30 pm)

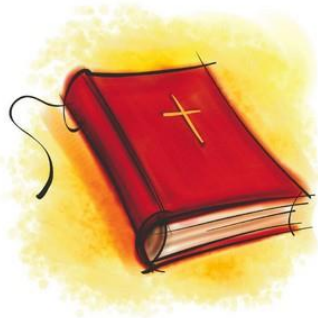
