Our deepest sympathy to the Paiement family on the passing away of Marlene, daughter of Margaret Paiement. Her funeral will be held at St. Columban.

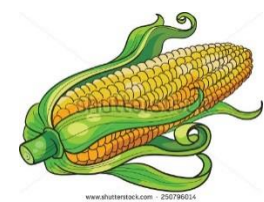
Also our deepest sympathy to the Brownrigg family on the passing away of Jim's mother, Jeannine, this week.

The accepted motion states that the current rental fees for use of the hall will apply to parishioners requesting the hall for personal use. Anyone wishing to rent the hall can consult with the Hall Warden (Brian Peters) to determine the applicable fee.

An exception to this rule will be for the use of the hall as part of a funeral for a deceased registered parishioner (St. Aloysius and St. Columban). No rental fees will be applied for the use of the hall in these circumstances. The parish's official list of registered parishioners will be used to determine the status of the parishioner in question.
